Sports Funding Proposal 2023-24

Since March 2013, the government has been allocating schools with a dedicated PE and sports premium 'to make additional and sustainable improvements to the quality of PE and sport they offer'. Both Schools in the Goldsborough Sicklinghall Federation are eligible. Funding varies based on the size of the school.

For a culture of movement and physical activity to be integral to a school's values, it is vital that objectives are given adequate time to move from developing to embedding to sustaining. 2023-24 is a mixture of the embedding and sustaining year for some objectives due to changes in subject leadership.
