Reminders:

- **Please check that you have ordered meals for your child for next week and future weeks.**
- **Sycamore Class will be visiting Herd Farm on Monday 29th April**

The coach will collect the **Goldsborough children first at 9:05am** before going to collect the children from Sicklinghall.

Sycamore class will need to be in school for 8:45am so that we can carry out the register and leave promptly. **Please do not block the coach in and consider parking somewhere else other than outside school.**

The children will be outside all day so will require weather appropriate clothing, and footwear and a waterproof coat. Jeans are not suitable.

They will also need a healthy packed lunch – no nuts/chocolate and no glass bottles. A sun hat/sun cream may be required depending on the weather. The site does tend to get muddy, so **wellies/boots are advised.**

The children will set back off at 2:30pm. The coach will **drop off Sicklinghall children off first at 3:00pm**, and **Goldsborough second at 3:30pm**. Please be prepared that the children may return late back to school – we will update you during the return journey via text.

Knaresborough Heritage Centre

We have been asked to forward the following information to families:

A family friendly Heritage Centre will open in Knaresborough on Saturday 27th April, aiming to bring the town's history to life. It is run by Knaresborough Museum Association volunteers and supported financially by the local community.

The first exhibition will be all about the archaeology of Knaresborough with information, artefacts and fossils on display and 3 screens to show different aspects of archaeology discovered in the town. A dedicated children's zone contains a dressing up area and a selection of books and activities centred around a Victorian school desk. Children will be able to follow time travellers Gallery Gus and Museum Maud to help them understand about the exhibition in amusing and entertaining ways. They will also feature in the activity packs which can be purchased from the small shop where visitor information is also available. The centre will be open 10am -4pm on Wednesdays, Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays. We look forward to you coming to visit. Adults are asked for minimum donation of £2 each, children can visit for free but must be accompanied by an adult. In school holidays there will be workshops and activities for children.

Additionally, there are walks held every Saturday at 2pm and monthly evening talks held at COGS (both are bookable for £5 per adult). Please see our website for further details.
