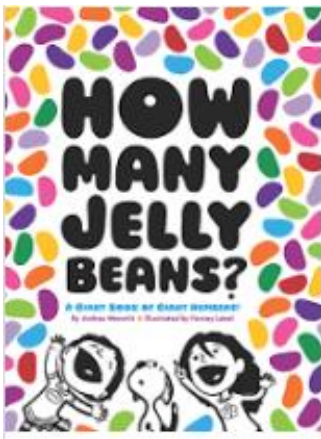

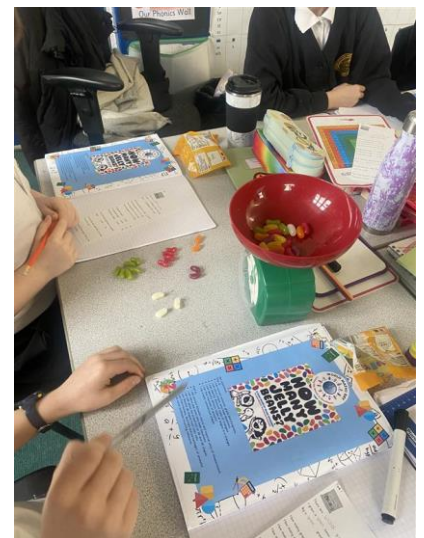
### Working Together for Excellent Attendance.


## Monthly Number Lottery
