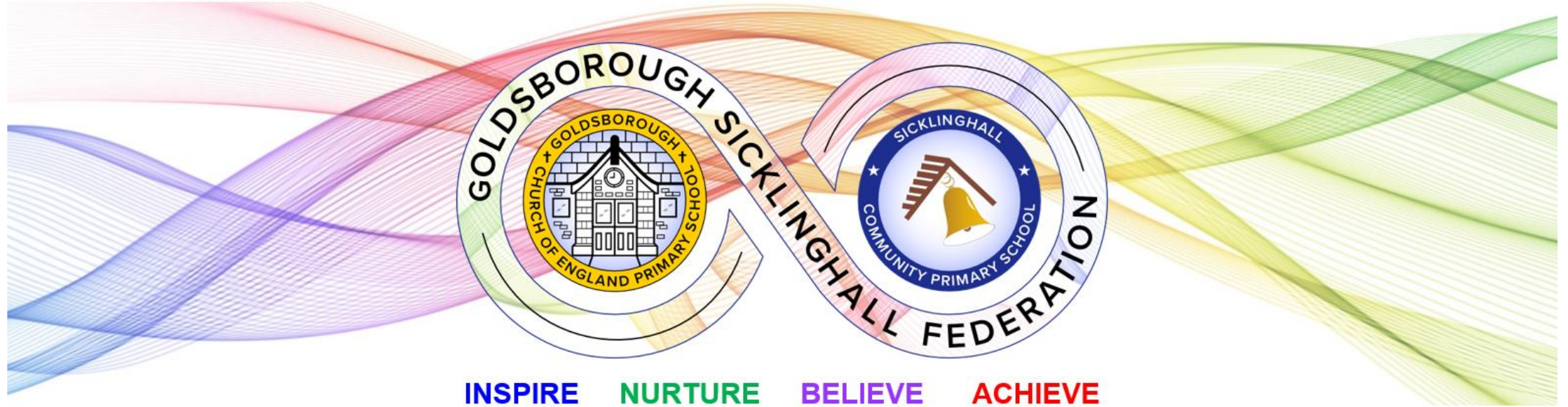

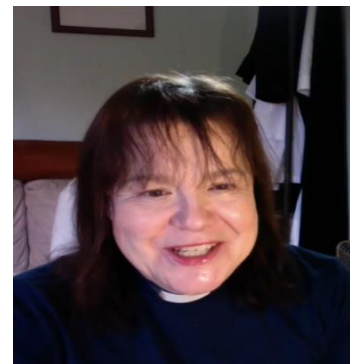

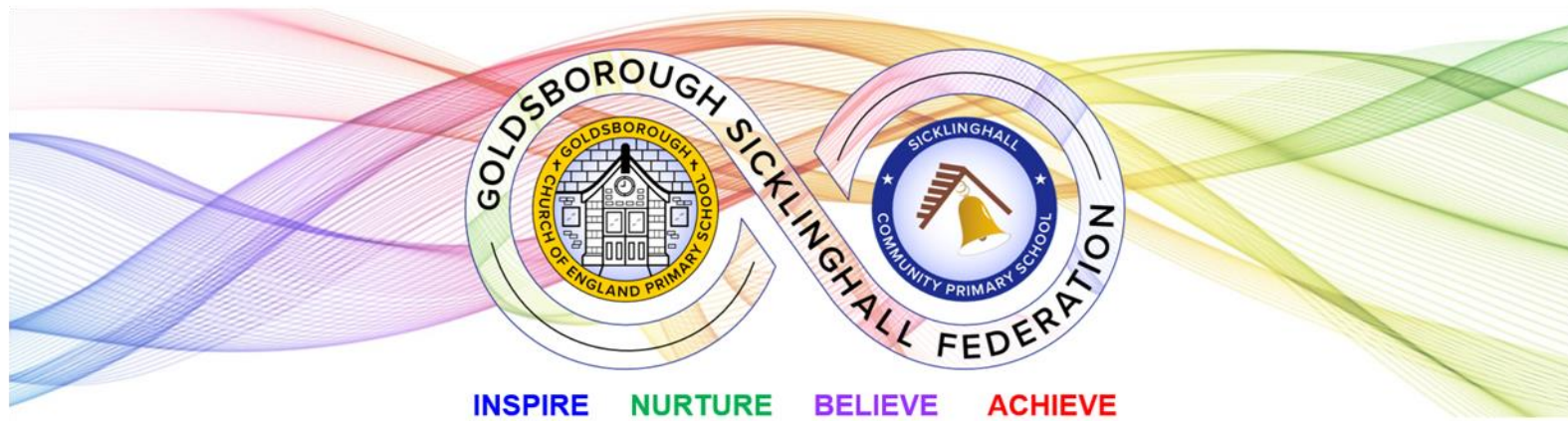

The Bible verse Ecclesiastes 4:9 continues:

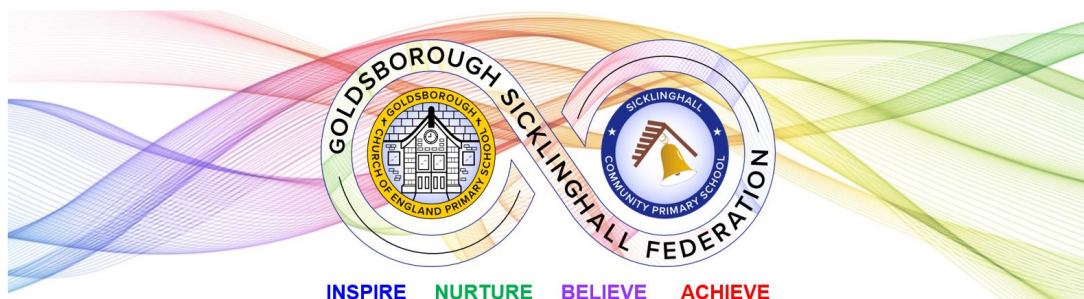
