Uniform

We have noticed as the term has gone on, more and more children wearing items that are not part of school uniform. We are always very understanding if there are specific needs regarding this but we must insist that school uniform is worn as expected.

Headlice continue to be a problem in school.

Please check your child's hair regularly. If you see lice or eggs, begin treatment immediately. **Hair should be combed daily (more often if possible) to remove the lice and eggs. Repeated combing is required over several days to completely rid the hair/head.**

You should check everyone in the house and start treating anyone who has head lice on the same day and continue combing relentlessly.

It is important that children are not being unkind to each other about this matter. Lice do not have anything to do with dirty hair and are picked up by head-to-head contact. It is preferable that long hair is worn tied back where possible.

The Christmas break provides the perfect time to get rid of headlice so that we can be a nit free school. Please check hair daily during this time period.

Breakfast and After School Club

Please note that where possible, Breakfast Club and After School Club should be paid for in advance. If your child regularly uses the clubs, please consider adding some credit to ParentPay, which will then be reduced by the appropriate amount each time your child attends a session.

Please also remember to book places in advance with Mrs Clayton, so that she is aware of how many children to expect and cater for.
