Reminders:

Den building on Tuesday 16th April: The children can **come to school** in their 'Outdoor Learning' clothes on the day of the workshop – no denim please. They will need lots of layers. The best clothing is jogging bottoms and a long-sleeved top. They will need a waterproof jacket. They could bring waterproof over-trousers too if they have some.
