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## Smarty Art After School Club

Smarty Art is offering an Art and Craft After School Club run by a qualified, experienced teacher, Mrs Fiona Ashford. The club is open to children Reception-Year 6 who wish to experiment, have fun and get messy!

Each session provides experiences to explore different materials and mediums. Next half term we will be exploring collage alongside looking at and creating the work of a famous Artist. We will also be getting the opportunity to explore the outdoors creating our own nature art.

The sessions offer great opportunities to develop a variety of skills in a social and safe environment.

Sessions will run on Wednesdays 3.15-4.15pm commencing 5<sup>th</sup> June . The course will run for **6 weeks (no session 10/7)** and the cost is **£42** per child . This covers the cost of materials involved and each child takes home their masterpieces. Places are limited to 18 on a first come first served basis. If your child would like to take part please sign up and pay on ParentPay.

## Money owed
