Interventions and Support



Due to the significant loss of curriculum time during the pandemic, it is likely that most children will need some additional support this year - this may be academic, or to support their Social, Emotional and Mental Health or SEND needs. Interventions may target children who need to catch up and also children who are targeted to achieve Greater Depth to ensure that have consolidated and understood concepts taught in lessons.

Interventions may be a one off, ad-hoc, weekly, or for a set period e.g. a half term or term either individually or in small groups. These are carefully planned by Teachers alongside the HT, AHT and SENCO. As a Governing Board, we understand the value of interventions and the impact they can have on a child's confidence. If you have any questions, please speak to the class teacher.

Leadership Across the Federation

Between Mrs Richards and myself, our aim is for one of us to see parents either at the start or end of the day on the playground as much as possible.

Mrs Richards works every Monday – Wednesday. Usually, on Mondays Mrs Richards will be at Goldsbrough and I will be at Sicklinghall. Wednesday is our Strategic Development Day and usually is packed full of meetings and trainings so we will not be on the playground on that day.

On Thursdays and Fridays, I will aim to be across both schools. We know that this doesn't always go to plan!
